What types of incident should I be notifying to the Local Authority Safeguarding Team?

Unless you have a locally agreed Safeguarding threshold you should notify all the following types of incident to the Local Authority & CQC:



Any form of abuse: physical, domestic, sexual, psychological, emotional, discriminatory, financial, material, organisational or institutional.

Neglect, self-neglect or Acts of Omission
